Attendance

We were pleased to note a reduction is school persistent absences figures from December. We see first hand the impact on the progress of children who are away from school for frequent or extended periods of time. It is a sobering thought to recognise that the primary education years pass so quickly and this critical missed time in school can never be regained...time moves on! After a period of absence (extended or frequent) some children may feel disorientated as their classmates are using and developing skills and knowledge from the previous week and catching up can be challenging.

We <u>must</u> return to our pre Covid attendance figures across the school, simply for the **benefit of all of our children**. We will increase our engagement with the attendance service with the Local Authority to help all our children. We look at the classes with varying attendance rates and look at individual patterns of attendance.

We know that when children are sick and unfit to be in school then we expect them to be absent but when appointments are made, we are now reminding everybody that absence should really be confined to either a morning or afternoon session; not the whole day. When children are collected mid-afternoon for appointments we ask that parent or carer shows us some formal notification of the appointment. Thank you

We have been greatly supported by our parent body with regular attendance of their children but we need to see our attendance figures rising further. **PLEASE do everything in your capacity to aim for high attendance for your children**. New skills knowledge, trips activity, exciting curriculum, residential, workshops, playtimes, fairs, charity events, gardening, games, friendships sport, competitions, clubs morning and afternoon etc all these aspects contribute to a rich and stimulating experience for our children and life-long happy memories are made through sustained primary school attendance.
